

NO W EY INCINERATOR

Welcome to the No Wey Incinerator Action Group - which is now energetically working to develop active opposition to the Veolia incinerator proposal.

Our steering committee, composed of a number of highly committed local residents, is preparing the most effective objections to this planning application, which is expected to be submitted by late April. This time scale may change in the light of the current Covid 19 situation, but the group intends to be fully prepared to respond as soon as the application is lodged. There will then be a 30 day consultation period for the receipt of public comments and the group will advise on how to compose valid objections that will count with the planners. It will also be extremely important to object individually during this period, rather than as households.

Since our meeting in Froyle, the action group has been extremely busy taking advice from planning consultants, environmentalists and landscape specialists. We are also seeking funding from local supporters to ensure the best professional advisers guide us.

Ben Stanberry, a key member of the group has agreed to be our spokesman and has produced a YouTube video which powerfully conveys the key arguments against incineration in general and this proposal in particular.
